Ages 4-11 Years

Barnaby Bear

Age Group: Year 2
Group size: Up to 35 children
Duration: 1 hour in school; 1 hour at London City Airport

Barnaby Bear engages students in learning about geography, transport and travel in a fun and interactive way. Airport volunteers visit your local school to deliver a one hour interactive presentation based on things to see and do in London and a literacy based activity session. A week later the students visit London City Airport to see Barnaby Bear off on his flight, and learn more about London.



Story Building Workshop 'The Exciting Life of London City Airport'

Age Group: Year 5
Group size: Up to 30 children
Duration: 1 hour 45 minutes



The programme involves delivery of the story of London City Airport past, present and future, followed by a creative writing workshop. The Airport story is told with colourful cartoon drawings by an Airport Volunteer, and then students are supported to write their own story through completion of the story workbook provided. The programme encourages students to think creatively about creating characters and writing stories.

City-Zenship Programme

Age Group: Year 3
Group size: Up to 30 children
Duration: 2 hours

Children are given a tour of the airport to see staff at work. The tour is followed by an employment focused workshop during which the students discuss what it means to go out to work. Volunteers from different Airport departments then host activities and role play sessions before distributing 'payslips' for the children to consider and discuss.



Unescorted Tours

Age Group: Nursery to Year 3
Group size: Up to 15 children
Duration: 1 hour

Airport visits are a great way to allow lessons from the classroom to be viewed in action. For years aged under seven, a landside visit pass is available for teachers and adults to bring groups into London City Airport. Landside Tours

Age group: Years 4 to 6
Group size: Up to 15 young people
Duration: 1 hour

Visitors are introduced to areas of the Airport not normally accessible to the public. Guests are escorted around the landside areas of the terminal and hear about the history and future plans for London City Airport.
